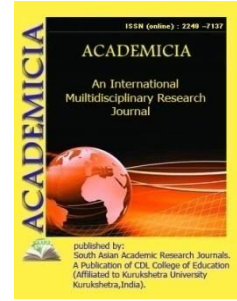




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**THE STATUS AND DYNAMICS OF THE RAISE OF THE ACTIVE

 PROBLEMS AND CHALLENGES**

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**ABSTRACT**

*The hereby article analyzes the issue of the status and dynamics of the growth of active citizenship and initiative of young people of Uzbekistan by doing a comparative analysis with foreign experience. It also highlights the mutual correlation of material factors with particular socio-psychological phenomenon in the current development of social trust among youth of the country and identifies the main tasks.
