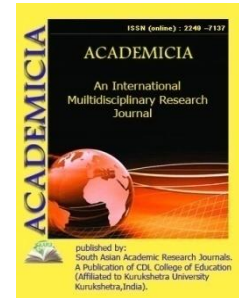




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**INCREASING PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT IN PRE-SCHOOL

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ABSTRACT
