




ABSTRACT

The article is devoted to the extremely topical issue of choosing the most effective methods of teaching foreign languages to students of higher education institutions, which can provide motivation for learning a foreign language and increase students' activity. The role and importance of informational and pedagogical technologies have been determined, as well as the effectiveness and expediency of their introduction into the educational process of the educational establishment has been substantiated.
