


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UZBEK LANGUAGE ABOUT LINGUISTIC NATURE OF AUXILIARY WORDS

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ABSTRACT

In this article, one of the auxiliary words of the Uzbek language - some of the issues that cause controversy around the assistants was expressed. In this place, we want to emphasize the same thing, they always remember the idea that "auxiliary words come from independent words", acting as a bridge between independent words and auxiliary words in a certain sense.
