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SECOND HIGHER EDUCATION AS AN IMPORTANT FORM OF TRAINING COMPETITIVE PERSONNEL IN UZBEKISTAN

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ABSTRACT

The country's higher education is designed to train highly qualified personnel with subsequent employment in various spheres of social and economic activity. An innovative approach to the process of reforming the second higher education showed that the most important form of expanding the admission of creative youth to study is the awareness of the need to obtain a second higher education. The country has created a legal framework for representatives of all social groups wishing to enter universities to receive education in a second specialty.
